Design Brief

Port Stephens Council has **two sites available for Port Stephens artists** to temporarily exhibit their artwork. Terrace Reflections & Yacaaba Walk of Art are ongoing place activation initiatives that support artists to display artwork in an outdoor environment for the whole community to enjoy and experience. The program objectives are to:

- Inspire the community's imagination, allowing them to engage with arts and culture beyond the confines of a museum or gallery
- Enhance Raymond Terrace's and Nelson Bay's built environment and create a vibrant gateway to the main streets
- Reinforce the unique identity and history of Raymond Terrace and Nelson Bay
- Provide a highly visible platform for creative expression and development
- Provide an opportunity for emerging and professional artists to exhibit their artworks.

About Terrace Reflections

- The designated exhibition space has two options to choose from:
 - 7 x square artworks (2m x 2m)
 - 3 x rectangle artworks (2m H x 5m W) + 1 x square (2m x 2m)
- A name and brief information about the exhibition, QR code and the artist will be displayed on a wall sticker alongside the artworks (2.3 m x 1.5 m) .
- Located of the corner of William & Sturgeon Street, Raymond Terrace.
- An artists fee of **\$3000**, excluding GST, will be paid to the successful artist

About Yacaaba Walk of Art

- The designated exhibition space is 4 panels in total:
 - 2 x rectangle artworks (1.2m H x 1.7m W)
 - 2 x rectangle artworks (1.2m H x 1.8m W)
- The name of artist and artwork will be displayed on a wall sticker alongside the artworks along with a QR code (300x300mm circles).
- Located on the corner of Donald & Yacaaba Street, Nelson Bay.
- An artists fee of **\$2000**, excluding GST, will be paid to the successful artist

General Information

The exhibitions will be part of an annual program of works, with each exhibition running for 3 months with the exception of the Christmas exhibition which will run for 2 months.

- December 2024 to January 2025
- February to April 2025
- May to July 2025
- August to October 2025
- December 2025 to January 2026

The space will display original works that have been scanned and printed on to vinyl banners and framed with sail tracks. Works can be submitted as developed digital files

ready for printing, or delivered to Port Stephens Council as 2D artwork. The scanning, printing and installation will be undertaken by Council contractors.

Artists can submit an expression of interest for both public art sites.

Selected artists will sign an artist agreement with Council outlining the full legal terms and conditions, including copyright and use of artworks.

As part of our commitment to supporting Aboriginal artists, one exhibition per year will be from an Aboriginal artist.

Successful artists will be notified by the end of May with deadlines for final design to be advised.

How to Apply:

Artists are invited to submit their EOI in response to the brief. Your expression of interest will include:

- Contact details including name, mobile, email address and street address
- Current CV relevant to the opportunity (maximum 2 pages)
- Relevant experience and examples of previous work
- A brief concept sketch and statement about the design/purpose and methodology

Please note the concept sketch and statement can be submitted in writing (no more than 500 words), rough sketch or digitally rendered form. This is not a request for a refined artistic design.

The selection panel will consist of members from Port Stephens Council staff and the Strategic Arts Committee.

In selecting a concept, the panel will consider:

- How the proposal meets the projects outlined objectives
- Originality of the artwork
- Relevance to proposed location
- Proposed methodology (materials)
- Artist/s experience
- Demonstrated understanding of the brief, and
- Ability to stimulate audience engagement and participation.
