It is a condition of entry that performers either live or are schooled in Port Stephens.

Key Dates

Applications open from the Wednesday 7 February 2024 and closes on Sunday 3 March, 2024 at midnight.

All applications will be assessed by Port Stephens Council and successful applicants will be notified by 5pm on Tuesday 12 March, 2024.

Technical/Dress rehearsal will be held on 11 April 2024.

Performance night will be held on 12 April 2024.

Funding Available

Battle of the Arts participants will have the opportunity to win prizes for their performance including the major prize of \$500.

Application Assessment

All application forms to be uploaded via the Smarty Grants portal by midnight on Sunday 3 March, 2024. No entries will be considered after this time / date.
